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ND A+ Interim Assessments Overview

The ND A+ Interim Assessments are based on North Dakota State Academic Content Standards. This assessment is relatively short and based on a blueprint that covers a broad set of assessable academic standards for grades 9 and 11-12 and for grade 10 is proportionately smaller than the ND A+ Summative Assessment blueprint.

High School reading and math are currently fixed forms, or non-adaptive, with plans to make them computer adaptive in the future. As we move to high school computer adaptive tests, high school reporting will eventually look like the current grade 3-8 reporting. The high school interim assessments are an untimed test, although most students complete the assessment in about 35-40 minutes.

The ND A+ Interim Assessments are designed to provide scores for a specific content area (i.e., math or reading) and show growth in student performance between interims within a given instructional year. In addition, after the 24/25 interims and summative assessment are complete, and the ND standard setting results are finalized, we will establish a predictive link between performance on the interim and summative assessments. This link will connect the scale scores and performance levels across the assessments and provide a way to predict summative performance based on interims results.

Due to the shorter length of the interim assessments, a student must answer all questions to receive a score. If they do not answer all questions, within performance reporting they will show as Do Not Report.

High School Score Reporting Information

ND A+ Interim Assessments report an overall scale score and performance level for each assessment test taken.

Scale Scores and Performance Levels

ND A+ Interim Assessments for high school report on overall content area performance using scale scores and performance levels. Scale scores are raw scores that have been adjusted and converted to a standardized scale to enable comparisons of student performance across tests within a subject area and grade level.

Students are placed into performance levels based on where their score falls in the distribution of the ND A+ Interim Assessment scale scores. Results provide visualizations indicating where average scores or a student's score falls within the scale score ranges.

Program Report

The **Program Report** shows aggregate student performance data for each test. Once two interims or more are completed, you can view data from multiple interims to make comparisons across ND A+ Interim Assessments administrations (i.e., Interim 1, Interim 2, Interim 3).

The report can be filtered to include specific grades, content areas, and test windows. At the top right, there is an **Export Report** button.

Performance Report

The **Performance Report** shows student progress and performance on each test at the district or school level. A variety of views and filters are available to access data for individual schools and classrooms. The Performance Report shows the average scale score and performance level earned by students on the test. Administrators can look at student performance across schools or classes (based on district or school admin status) as well a comparison to the state averages.
